Standing Items	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Update State Council:</u> Christian Surjan provided an update from the State TSE Council. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Two application were approved for EIRMC, Stroke Level II and STEMI level I. ○ RTTDC was held on August 30th in Cascade and was very successful. There was 26 attendees which is impressive given how quickly it was brought together. There are plans to have additional classes in the future. ○ The Insurance requirements for the site surveyors has been lifted and contracts will be going out to those that have been approved by the council. There are several site visits pending. ○ There is a request from the State council to develop a regional mass casualty plan. The group discussed it and decided to task the Trauma Subcommittee to develop a regional plan. • <u>EMS Update:</u> Canyon County Paramedics will be switching from Phillips to Zoll defibrillators. • <u>Coordination of Care:</u> The group reiterated the conversation from last month's meeting regarding high county rescue including Two Bear Air out of Montana or the use of the National Guard. The reality is the National guard is a resource, but may take several hours to mobilize. Two Bear Air is purely for rescue and has a limited range. Most communication will need to run through State Comm to coordinate. • <u>Community Outreach/Prevention:</u> Several outreach and prevention activities are planned. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Saint Alphonsus will be at the Capital Market booth providing education on trauma prevention. ○ St. Lukes is holding their annual Fit One expo and will be having a CPR only event ○ Marsing is starting a EMT course starting the end of September ○ St. Lukes Children's Hospital is starting a prevention effort on falls out of windows in conjunction with car seat installation and in Pediatric offices ○ Saint Alphonsus 11th annual Ski & Mountain Trauma Conference is being held Nov 3-5 in Sun Valley.
