October 5 2016 @ 14:00 at St Luke's Magic Valley Regional

Kevin opened meeting @ 1409. Minutes from last meeting approved. First and seconded by Kevin Kraal and seconded by Brenda Gully

Kevin-State Update: Will divert this to Christian.

EKG's: SLMVRMC ED transmission. This process has been cleared through legals and there will be no liability on the EPSI group. The current set up may be a charge from Phillips vs. Zoll. Carson Snowder was introduced to the group. Carson joins us from SLMVRMC Quality. There was discussion from Christian about a certain app that they use sort of like a "Snapchat" app and will delete itself within a certain time frame. Dr. Kraal will get the information for the ED transmission of EKG's to Mark Phillips.

Kraal and Christian will forward the question from Jay about TXA to GI Bleeds/Intracranial Hemorrhage to the state level.

STATE UPDATE: From Christian Bonner County submitted their Level 4 Trauma application. They are the 20th to submit their application

RTTDC (Rural Trauma Team Development Course) was discussed. Christian explained the process and what the course entails. It is a course based towards rural facilities and EMS agencies. American College of Surgeons supports this course.

Trauma registry has finished a 10 month STEMI or CVA data collection period. They are looking at all the data. Christian will give us a follow up next month on what the data looks like at this time.

Kraal discussed the GAP Analysis for the STEMI program for SLMVRMC and we have the GAP done for Stoke, and GAP is completed for trauma as well. Christian discussed the process and how many small facilities are having to start from the ground up. They have found that there are facilities that are now just starting QA programs. Christian states that a lot of the small facilities are starting to adopt the Trauma standards for all patient in the system.

Christian talked about offering an incentive to the EMS for the TSE program. This will allow for agencies to be recognized for their hard work. It may be a multi-level program. Benchmarks will be set as this program progresses. This is ONLY in its infancy and brainstorming.

Kevin Kraal asked for any more questions for Christian-there are none at this time.

Kent Holyoak motioned for meeting to go to closed session, Lara McClean seconded the motion. All confidentiality forms signed and handed in.

At 1500 Kevin Kraal presented an ASL/Magic Valley Paramedics case review on a CVA.

At 1538 Brandy moved to close the closed session with Brenda seconds that motion.

At 1544 a motion was made and seconded to close the meeting by Brenda and Brandy.
